VEEM has recently launched its patented Interceptor Propeller™ technology which lets you adjust the effective pitch of its fully CNC machined propellers. This is achieved with an exchangeable protruding plastic strip on the trailing edge of the pressure face of each blade. This protruding strip, or Interceptor, creates a 'water wedge' which changes the water flow over the blade - the higher the Interceptor, the higher the propeller pitch. The Interceptor strips, which are colour coded to easily identify their height, can even be changed underwater in just a few minutes. Changing strips now allows alterations to propeller pitch at any time, so that changes in boat weight or trim, windage caused by adding towers or clears, running tanks full to maximise range or even chasing top end speed at your local fishing tournament; can all be easily accommodated.
